

By virtue of a Warrant from the Commiss^{rs} of Property bearing Date the 15th day of the first Month 171³ & Resurveyd on the 9th of the Second month 1714 unto Henry Comley a Tract of Land lying in Warminster Township in the County of Bucks Beginning at a black oak in the ^{Line} _D Dividing the Counties of Philad^a and Bucks being a Corner of Samuel Carpent^{rs} Land Thence by the Same North East three hundred pches to a Corner White Oak Then by Jonas Jones Land South East One hundred & Seventy pches to a Corner Post Then by the Land of Nicholas Gilbert three hundred perches to a post in the said Division line Then by the said Line North West One hundred ^{& Seventy} pches to the place of Beginning Containing three hundred acres and an Allowance of Six Acres $\frac{1}{2}$ Cent.
