11th of ye 4th mo: 1712 to Survey unto John Decon ^{1000. acs} in Right of 1500.
Decon purchaser of 2500 Acres, Surveyed and laid out unto the
sd John Decon a tract of Land in Hilton township in Bucks County
Beginning at a Post in the County Line from thence Extending
North West by the sd Line 220 perches to a Post. Then North East
by vacant of James Logan's Land 365 perches to a heap of stones by
a White Oak, Then by the sd James Logan's Land South East 220
perches to a Post, Then South West by Vacant Land 365 perches
to the place of beginning Containing five hundred acres.
Surveyed the 12th of the 6th month 1715. Given under my hand.
