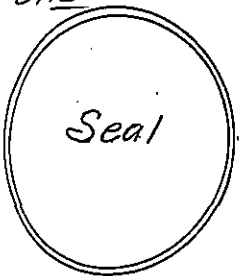


Pennsylvania S.S.

By the Commissioners of Property.

At the Request of John Edwards of the County of Bucks that we would Grant him to take up Two hundred acres of Land in the Great Swamp in ye Said County, for which he agrees to pay to the Proprietors use thirty pounds for the whole and the usual yearly quitrent of one Shilling Sterling for each Hundred Acres These are to authorize and Require thee to survey or cause to be Surveyd unto the Said John Edwards in the place aforesaid according to the Method of Townships appointed the Said quantity of Two Hundred Acres of Land that has not been already Surveyd nor appropriated nor is Seated by Indians and make a Return thereof into the Secretary's Office which Survey in case the Said John fulfill the above agreement within three months after the date hereof shall be valid otherwise the same is to be void as if it had never been made nor this Warrant ever granted,

Given under our hands and Seal of the Province at Philadelphia the 17th day of ye 9th moth Anno Din 1715,
