

By virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietary and Governour bearing Date the 27th day of September 1701, There was Surveyd and Laid out the 4th of the 3^d month 1703 unto Richard Pike five hundred acres of Land in Right of Ralph Crispin purchaser of the Said quantity Situate in the County of Philadelphia beginning at a Spanish Oak in the Line of Limbreck Township, Then by the Land of Nathaniel Puckle North East four hundred Sixty Seven perches to a black oak then by the free Societies Land North West One hundred Seventy two perches to a Black Oak sapling, Then South West by Vacant Land four hundred Sixty Seven perches to a Spanish Oak in the line of the Said Limbreck Township - Then in the Said Line South east One hundred Seventy two perches to the beginning

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this 26th day of October 1909
