

In Pursuance of a Warrant from the Commissioners of Property bearing Date the 13th day of the 8th Month 1716 There was Survey'd and Layd out to Thomas Edward of the County of Philadelphia two hundred ^{Seventy Six} acres of Land at Oley in the Said County being the Re-
-mainder of One thousand acres originally ^{purchased} of the Proprietary by Thom^s Bond of Woodacre in the County of ^{Lancaster} ~~York~~ in Great Britain Beginning at a Post at a Corner of Henry Kerson's land Thence Running North West by the same One hundred and thirty Perches to a post Thence North East by a line of trees three hundred and forty Perches Then South East by line of trees One hundred and thirty Perches Then South West by a Line of trees three hundred and forty Perches to the Beginning. Returned into the Secretary's Office the ___ day of April 1718
