At the Request of Sarah Stevenson Relict & Execut^{rix}
of Thomas Stevenson late of the County of Bucks Decd. that we
would Grant her to take up one Thousand Acres of Land part
of five Thousand Acres the purchase of Thomas Hudson
whose Attorney William Biles in his life time Granted & Convey'd
the same to Joseph Thorne (and others of Flushing on Long
Island) who by two Deeds poll dated ye 25th day of July 1718
and ye 11th day of June last past Granted & Convey'd the said
one Thousand Acres unto the Said Thomas Stevenson. These are to
authorize and Require thee to Survey or cause to be Survey'd
unto the said Sarah Stevenson within this Province according to the
Method of Townships appointed the said quantity of one Thousand
acres of Land that has not been already Survey'd nor appropriated
nor is Seated by the Indians and make Returns thereof into the
Secretarys Office in Order for a further Confirmation Given under our
Hands & the Seal of ye Province at Philadelphia the 10th day of
December Anno Domini 1719
