



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Commissioners Dated the fourth Day of March Anno Dom 1717 Surveyed and laid out in the County of Philad^a Near Perkiorny a Tract of Land for Joseph Skippen beginning at a Post Near a blackoak markt for a Corner Thence by Land of Isaac Deboy North East five hundred and Sixteen perches to a Post thence by Vacant Land North West One hundred Twenty Two perches to a Post being a Corner of Limerick Township thence by Land of Joseph Pike South West five hundred and Sixteen perches to a Post thence South East One hundred Twenty Two perches to the place of beginning Containing Three hundred Sixty Nine Acres and Two thirds of an Acre with Allowance of Six $\frac{1}{2}$ Cent Surveyed October 18th 1726
