Whereas by Vertue of a Warr^t from the Proprietor bearing date the eleventh day of the Year One thousand Six hundred and Eighty three for laying out unto Richard Sneed of the City of Bristol Original Purchase of one thousand five hundred Acres of Land in this Province his Proportion of Land within the Liberties of the City of Philadelphia appurtenant to his Said Purchase there was Survey'd a certain Parcel or Parcels of Land wth in the said Liberties of w^{ch} the quantity is not as yet certainly known. These therefore are to Authorize and Require thee to Resurvey or cause to be Resurvey'd exactly to ye sd Richard Sneed all & every such parcel or parcels of Land within the said Liberties which have been already laid out to him in right of the Purchase aforesaid and in case the said parcel or parcels shall fall short of the quantity of twenty four Acres then to make up the same to that number ~~beyond~~ either adjoining to what is already laid, if it may be done or otherwise to make up ye deficiency out of such Vacaney as may be found ~~to~~ in the sd Liberties beyond the River Skuykill and make Returns into the Secretaries Office. Given under our hands and the seal of the Province at Philad^{ia} the 30th day of Novemb^r in the Year of our L^d 1708.
