

By virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietor and Governour bearing date the 29th of 8th 1701 for Surveying unto Joseph Pike five hundred acres of land in Right of Samuel Powl's first purchaser of five thousand acres There was Surveyd and Laid out the 29th day of the ninth Month 1701 to the said Joseph Pike the said Quantity of five hundred acres of land in the County of Philadel^a beginning at a post standing by the land of ~~the~~ Joseph Tanner and Extending thence by the said Tanners line Southwest five hundred perches to the second post Then by vacant land northwest one hundred and sixty perches to a third post Then Northeast by vacant land five hundred perches to a fourth post Then Southeast one hundred & sixty perches to the place of the Beginning
