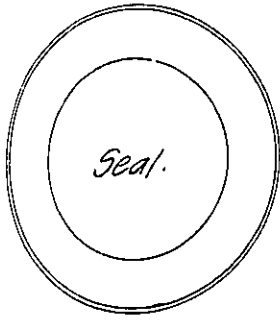


Pensilvania fo.

By the Commissioners of Property

At the Request of Joshua Calvert of the County of Chester that we would grant him to take up one hundred acres of land in the Manner of Rocklands for which he agrees to pay to the Propriet^{rs} use thirty pounds m^ony of Pensilvania within three months after the date hereof and the yearly Quitrent of one Shilling Sterling for ever. These are to Authorize & Require thee to Survey or cause to be Survey'd unto the said Joshua Calvert in the said Manner Contiguous to the Surveys there already made the said quantity of one hundred acres of Land that has not been heretofore Survey'd nor appropriated and make Returns thereof into the Secretarys Office which Survey in case the said Joshua-fulfill the above agreement shall be valid otherwise the same is to be void as if it had never been made nor this Warrant ever granted given under our hands & Seal of the Province at Philadelphia the 25th day of the first month Anno Dni 1718
