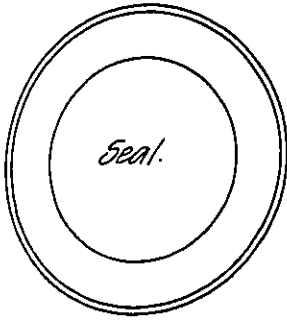

By the Commiss^{rs} of Property.

At the Request of Benjamin Chambers That (In pursuance of a grant made to him by the Proprietary before his departure) We would grant him to take up in behalf of Peter Blam and James Hunt two of the Kentish Purchasers about two hundred acres of land at ye Eastern Corner of & adjoining to the Tract laid out to the s^d Kentish Purchasers near Brandywine in ye County of Chester out of the land taken up by Anthony Weston & Burgess and by them quitted to compensate in some measure the barrenness of ye s^d Tract for which he hath agreed to pay after ye rate of twelve pounds for every hundred Acres & so proportionably upon the Survey thereof: These are to Authorize thee to Survey or cause to be Survey'd to ye s^d Benjamin for ye use of ye s^d Peter & James - the s^d number of two hundred Acres or thereabouts out of the s^d Land and make Returns thereof into the Secretaries Office. Which Survey in case the s^d Benjamin comply with ye Agreem^t afores^d shall be valid otherwise shall be void & of no other effect than if the same had never been made nor this Warr^t ever granted. Given under our hands & the Seal of the Province at Philad^{ia} the 31st of 10^{br} 1701.
