These are to will & Require thee forthwith to take care that so much Land be admeasured to him according to ye method & forme of Townshipp which I have appointed in such cases & make returne hereof into my Secretarys Office & for so doing this shall be thy sufficient Warrt Given under my hand & Seal at Chester this 25th of ye 10th Month 1682.
