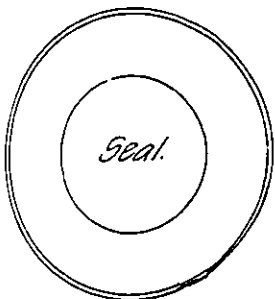


Pensylvania

Whereas Peter Dicks now settled in Brommingham Township in the County of
 Chester hath requested us to grant him three hundred acres of Land on the South^{West}
 Side of Brandywine opposite to his Plantation for which he hath agreed to pay fifty
 pounds, eighteen pounds thereof in hand and the remaining thirty two pounds in
 six months after the date hereof to be held under the ^{yearly} Rent of one Shill^{ings} Sterl.
 P. hundred: These therefore are to Require thee to Survey and lay out to the sd Peter
 Dicks the sd number of three hundred acres of land where vacant in the place
 afores^d and make returns thereof into the Surveyor's Office at Philad^{ia} where this
 Warrant is to remain and a Copy thereof attested by the Secretary to be transmitted
 to thee who is also to take a Duplicate of thy Return into his Office. Given under our
 hands and the Seal of the Province at Philadelphia the 4th of the 12th month
 1701
