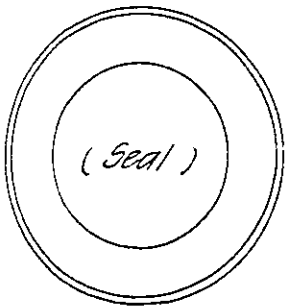


Pennsylvania
