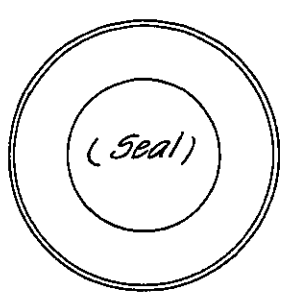

*At the Request of David Evan That we would grant him a Resurvey on two  
Several Tracts of land adjoining laid out in the Borders of the Welch Tract near New-  
town for one hundred and fifty four acres each, by vertue of a General Warr<sup>t</sup> from  
the Prop<sup>ty</sup> for laying out the said tract bearing date the 15<sup>th</sup> of the first month 1684  
in right of two purchases made by Evan ap. William and David Evan of Richard  
Davies first Purchaser of 5000 Acres: These are to require thee forthwith to re-  
survey to the sd David Evan the said two Tracts of land according to the just Complet<sup>t</sup>  
they ought to contain and make returns thereof into the General Surveyor's Office at  
Philadelphia where this Warrant is to remain and a copy thereof to be delvd to  
thee attested by the Secretary who is also to take a Duplicate of thy Return into  
his Office: Given under our hands and the Seal of the Province at Philadelphia  
the 18<sup>th</sup> of the 12<sup>th</sup> Mo<sup>th</sup> 1701*
