Surveied for richard fewes one tract of land lieng one the east side of upland creek beginning at a marked red oak near the Creekside and running along the said creek on severall courses to a marked popler from thence up a small run one severall courses to a marked popler from thence N. E. b. E. 340 Pertch to a marked white oak standing by prester creek from thence on severall courses along the creek side to a marked red oak from thence S. W. b. W. 255 pertch to ~~a marked red oak standing~~ the first marked tree by upland creekside being Surveied for 227 acres.
