Purchased the Same _____ These are to Authorize and Require thee to Survey or cause to be Survey'd to the Said Jn^o Davies according (obl) the Method of Townships appointed the Said quantity of Two Hundred and fifty Acres of Vacant Land in this Province that has not been already Survey'd nor taken up nor is Seated by the Indians. and make Returns thereof into the Secretaries Office. Given under our hands and the Seal of the Province at Philad^{ia} the 20th day of the 11th Moth A.D. 171³/₄
