By the Commissioners of Property

At the Request of John Davis of Philad^a that We would Grant him to take up the City Lots and the Proportion of Liberty Land appurtenant to twelve Hundred and fifty Acres of Land the Original purchase of William Kent made of the late Proprietary by Deeds of Lease & Release dated y^e 17 & 18th days of October 1681 the Right whereof being now Vested in y^e said John Davis These are to Authorize and Require thee to Survey & Lay out or cause to be Survey'd and laid out unto the said John Davis in the Right aforesaid the City Lots belonging to the said Purchase of twelve Hundred & fifty Acres in that Part of the City where they fell or as near thereunto as possible and also the Liberty Land within the Liberties where the same may be found Vacant and make exact Returns ~ into the Secretarys Office Given under our hands & the seal of the Province at Philadelphia the 10th day of y^e 11th Month Anno.
