mer war<sup>t</sup>s whereof I have -obl- by me severall that have warts for  
that Creek, & I keep them, untill I have an account from thee of the  
laying out the two Townshipp at pemapecca. the perseusuances  
& number of acres there to be placed now in my custody are  
as underneath: make me a returne here of both of the pro-  
tracted figure & originall field work which are to remain  
in my office. philadelphia 21<sup>st</sup> 3<sup>m</sup> 1683
