Martha Bization's Land thence Downn ye S<sup>th</sup> river 385 perches to a Locust Tree  
thence N.E. by N. by vacant Land 400 perches to a White Oak thence west north  
west by vacant Land 380 perches to a Black Oak thence South W. by south. by y<sup>e</sup>  
S<sup>th</sup> Martha Bization's Land 436 perches to y<sup>e</sup> place of Beginning.
