Courses and Distances

Begins at a corner on the line of Schuylkill County, at a point of Wana Runes of 100 miles and 100 perches to a corner on Little Mahanoy Creek, thence N 45 E 5 miles and 100 perches to a corner on Bucks Mountain, thence S 30 E 4 miles and 100 perches to a corner in the line between Luzerne and Schuylkill or Northampton counties.

Note. No line could be run from several points contemplated by the Surveyor given in the act of Assembly.
