Courses and Distances

beginning at a corner on the line of Schuylkill county,
at a heap of stones there N 1/2 E 3 miles and 100 paces
to a corner on Little Mountain there N 45 E 5 miles
and 100 paces to a corner on Bucks Mountain there
S 70 E 9 miles and 100 paces to a corner in the line be-
tween Luzerne and Schuylkill or Northampton counties.

Note. No line could be run to the several points con-
templated by the distances given in the act of Assembly.
