Robert Atkins of Bedford County and State of Pennsylvania - knowing the necessity of life, and being also convinced that it is the duty of every man when of sound mind disposing his mind, money & understanding so to leave and dispose of his worldly estate that when death puts an end to his own enjoyment of it, there to remain duty and affection makes him think proper to leave it every man to a certainty what is left or intended for those - therefore I do this twenty second day of November in the Year of our Lord - One thousand eight hundred and sixteen and ordain that my last Will and Testament - In manner following, there it is my Will and I order and direct that Martin Reily, of Bedford, shall succeed to inherit and enjoy all my Estate, Real & Personal of what kind soever, and to enjoy all and singular the Donation Lands to which I am entitled for serving as a Sergeant in Capt. & John Gough's Company of Pennsylvania Rangers - Commanded by me in the years 1792 and 1793 and to enjoy all and singular the lands to which I am entitled by an Act of Congress, for services rendered the United States, by me - summing all some & abating and comprising this and no other and for my last Will and Testament - In things whereof I have received God my hand this 11th day above
