

Know all men by these presents that I Abraham Wood of South Huntington Township in Westmoreland County - Soldier during the war <sup>with England</sup> in Captain John Boyd's Company of Rangers - have made ordained and in my stead and place put and constituted Benjamin Lodge Esq: of said County my true and Lawful attorney Inrevocable for me and in my name and to my use to ask Demand and receive from the Board of War (or Wherever it may be obtained) the Right for what Land I am Intituled to as a Conation, for my Services - and to do every Lawful act and thing concerning the premises as fully in every Respect as I my self might or could do if I were personally present hereby ratifying and allowing all and whatsoever my said attorney shall in my name Lawfully do in and about the premises - In Witness Whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this sixteenth Day of August 1797
