Thomas Campbell Esq; came before me the Subscriber one of the Justices of the Peace in and for said County and upon his solemn oath both before and say that he was well acquainted with Thomas Boyd late a Lieutenant in the first Pennsylvania Regt; and also with William Boyd late an Ensign in the 2<sup>d</sup> Regt. Pennsylvania Regt; both Brothers to John Boyd late of the first Pennsylvania Regt; and that Thomas Boyd while in actual service was killed by the Indians in what is generally called Indian Expedit<sup>ions</sup> on, and that William Boyd was killed at the Battle of Brantwinn and further with me
