presents Do nominate & appoint Trusty friend Joseph  
Salmon of the County & State afores<sup>d</sup> to repair to  
the Land Office of Pennsylvania and apply for said  
Burwell and for his use for a patent for two hundred  
Acres of Land Granted to him as a soldier and for him  
and in his name to give sufficient Receipt or Receipts  
& Discharges as full as he him self might or could have  
Done was he Personally present
