Office of the State of Pennsylvania for the donation land by
law accruing to the said George Calhoun and his heirs for
his services in the said line in the Army aforesaid: For
this, that the said George Calhoun was duly commissioned a Captain
in the said Regiment in the line aforesaid in the said Army
during the Continuance of the then existing War: That he
the said George Calhoun continued in the said line, and did duty
as a Captain therein until about the Year 1779 when he
died in the said Service in the Army aforesaid; without having
made any Will.
