Philad^a April 14th 1798

I Certify that on the 15th of November 1797. Mr John Moz-
lan of Philadelphia filed a claim in the said Office in be-
half of Captain Henry Carberry for Donation Land; that
in October 1795 John Nicholson Esq^r also filed a claim
to the said Land, under a Power of Attorney or transfer
from Captain Henry Carberry, as he alledges; that on
the 28th day of February 1794 the lot of Donation Land
numbered 107 containing 500 Acres in the 6th District
was granted to Captain Robert Coltman as an equiva-
lent for a lot of like quantity which was formerly
granted to him and afterwards found to lie in the State
of New York; and that in the last drawing of Dona-
tion Land by the Land Officers, the said lot No 107 came
out by mistake against the name of Captain Henry
Carberry owing to its not having previously been
taken from the wheel.
