KNOW all men by these presents that We William Bartley, & Mary Bartley, (Late Mary Chambers) of Millford Township, Mifflin County, State of Pennsylvania, the former of us being the Administrator, & Both Being the only Lawfull heirs to the Estates of John Chambers and James Chambers, Deceased, & Soldiers in the Late Revolutionary war With Great Britain;

We do make constitute and appoint and in our place and stead put and Depute William Beale, of the Township County and State aforesaid, our True & Lawfull Attorney for us and in our name to make application for, obtain and procure for us Warrants, or patents for what Donation Land is due to us from the State, of Pennsylvania, as the heirs of the said John and James Chambers Late Soldiers &c - Giving and granting unto our said attorney by these presents our full and whole power, strength, and authority in & about the premises to have, use & take all Lawfull means, in our name for the purposes aforesaid, And Generally, all & Every other act, or acts things, or things, whatsoever, needfull & necessary to be done in and about the premises, for us & in our name to do, execute & perform, as fully, Largely & amply, to all intents & purposes, as We ourselves might or could do if personally present at the doing thereof, and attorneys one or more under him for the purpose, aforesaid, to make and constitute, & ~~again~~ again at pleasure to revoke, hereby ratifying, allowing and holding for firm & good, all & whatsoever our said Attorney shall Lawfully do in & about the premises by Virtue hereof.
