State of Pennsylvania for divers good causes
& considerations me hereunto moving do
nominate constitute & appoint James Allison
my lawful Attorney in my name and
stead to apply to the Officers of the Land
Office of Pennsylvania in the mode pointed
out by Law for a title to that Portion of
Land which is due from the State of
Pennsylvania to me as a Soldier in the
Eighth Regiment of said State for my services
during the War & do hereby authorize
the said James Allison Squire to ask & demand
Receipts of the Officers aforesaid of the Office
aforesaid all Deeds & other writings as the
evidence of Title to said Land to which I
am entitled for my services as aforesaid
as if I were personally present & do
further ratify & confirm all acts done
by my said Attorney in the Premises

19th Day of June 1789
