
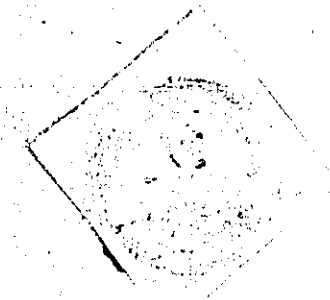


Know all Men by these Presents that I Blany Cochran late a Soldier

granted Bargained and sold unto him the said Thomas Denton
his heirs and Assigns, the Donation land due to me for My service
being two hundred acres. And I do hereby for Value Received Direct
and Require the officers appointed or to be appointed to issue said lands
to grant and Confirm the same unto him the said ^{for} Denton
I hereby Ratifying all that my said Attorney shall do in the Premises
as fully as if I was Personally Present. Witness My hand and Seal
the tenth Day of February A D 1794.
