State of Maryland } Anderson on her Oath, taken before me one of the Jus-  
tices of the Peace for said County - This deponent doth  
say that a certificate of Marriage between a certain  
Philip God & Jane God, was left in her care which  
certificate was lost or misplaced, & that they both  
lived together as man & wife. Certified & taken this  
Second day February, 1803 John Smith

On this 2<sup>d</sup> day of February 1803 came James  
McClain before me a Justice of the Peace for said  
County and on his Oath Deposits & saith that he knew  
the aforesaid Philip & Jane God to live together as  
Man & wife, & that he himself & the said Philip  
God were enlisted in the first Regiment in the  
Pennsylvania line, under the command of General  
Wayne, Colonel Harman, Major James Moor, Capt<sup>s</sup>  
John Sigler & Lieutenant James Robertson, & that  
he saw the <sup>sa</sup> Philip God killed, at Paoli & that he  
assisted at the burial of the said Philip God, &  
that he had also seen a certificate of Marriage  
between the said Philip & Jane God at various  
times - Certified & taken before me
