

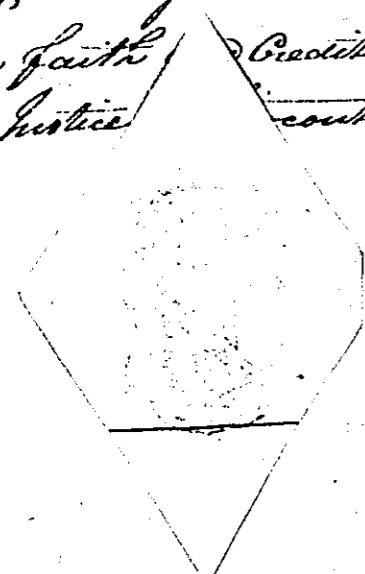

This eight day of June 1804

Before me James Steel one of the Justices of the Peace for the State of Maryland for Harford County Ralf Sims made oath on the holy Evangelist that he saw Philip God a certain James McClain and others who had resided in his neighbourhood in company with a Recruiting Sergeant early in the Revolutionary war and God and McClain informed him they were enlisted into the Continental Service for three years or during the war that they went off the next day and soon after marched under the command of John Watson who the Deponent understood was a Lieutenant in the Pennsylvania Line that after a number of years McClain returned and often told the Deponent God was killed at the Battle
