Barber of the County & State aforesaid my true & Lawfull Attorney for me the said John Dawson & in my name & for my use to ask recover & receive from the Secretary of the Land Office of the State aforesaid a Deed or Patent for two Hundred acres of Donation Land I am entitled to & Surveyed on the West Side of the River Ohio by my late Services as a Soldier in Capt. Robinsons Company of foot. and further I do hereby fully empower him the said J. Barber to do & execute all & every such further and other acts matters & things whatsoever which shall or may be requisite or expedient in and concerning the Premises as fully amply & Effectually to all intents & purposes as I the said John Dawson could or might do if I were personally present & I the said John Dawson do hereby agree to ratify & confirm whatsoever my said Attorney shall Legally or Lawfully do or Cause to be done in & concerning the premises by Virtue of these presents. In Witness whereof I the said John Dawson have hereunto set my hand & Seal this 9th Day of June in the Year of our Lord one thousand Seven Hundred & Eighty Seven 1787
