The Seventh Day of September in the year of Our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred and Eighty Nine, personally appeared before me Samuel Towel Esquire Mayor, of the said City James Dougherty who being duly sworn on the Holy Evangelists of Almighty God, did depose and declare, that he enlisted in the Armies of the United States in the year of Our Lord One Thousand seven Hundred and Seventy Eight in the Ninth Pennsylvania Regiment commanded by Colonel Nagle, and that he continued in different Regiments in the Service of the United States until the proclamation of the Peace, and that he was regularly discharged in Philadelphia in the Month of August in the year 1783 by Colonel Richard Humphreys: and also that he has not sold his Donation Land to any person or persons whatsoever.
