line soldiers in the service of the United States*  
have made, ordained, and constituted, and by these presents DO  
make, ordain and constitute, and in my Place and Stead put and  
depute *Joseph Smith*

true and lawful Attorney, for me and in my Name, and for my  
Use to ask, demand, sue for, recover and receive all such Sum  
and Sums of Money, Debts, Goods, Wares, Dues, Accounts, and  
other Demands whatsoever, which are or shall be due, owing,  
payable and belonging to me, or detained from me, by any Man-  
ner of Ways or Means whatsoever, by *the United States or any other State*  
*for my services rendered as aforesaid, and for a valuable consider-*  
*ation to me in hand paid, I do hereby give the above Joseph*  
*Smith to divide all my lands, pay and other emoluments what-*  
*soever for my services rendered as aforesaid, and also to sell and*  
*Make Good title for the same as if I were personally present*  
*With full power*

giving and granting unto my said Attorney, by these Presents, my  
full and whole Power, Strength and Authority in and about the  
Premises, to have, use, and take all lawful Ways and Means, in  
my Name for the Recovery thereof; and upon the Receipt of any  
such Debts, Dues, or Sums of Money aforesaid, Accittances, or  
other sufficient Discharges, for me and in my Name, to make,  
seal and deliver. And generally, all and every other Act or Acts,  
Thing and Things, Device and Devices, in the Law whatsoever,  
needful and necessary to be done in and about the Premises; for  
the Recovery of all or any such Debts or Sums of Money afore-  
said, for me and in my Name to do, execute and perform, as  
fully, largely, and amply, to all Intents and Purposes, as I myself  
might or could do if I were personally present, or as if the Mat-  
ter required more special Authority than is herein given. And  
Attorneys, one or more under *him* for the Pur-  
pose aforesaid, to make and constitute, and again at Pleasure to  
revoke. Ratifying, allowing, and holding for firm and effectual,  
all and whatsoever my said Attorney shall lawfully do in and a-
