in any Way belong to him and to pay the Debts in which the said Deceased
stood obliged, so far forth as the said Goods and Chattels, Rights and Cre-
dits, will extend, according to their Rate and Order of Law; especially
of well and truly administering the Goods and Chattels, Rights and Cre-
dits, which were of the said Deceased, and making a true and perfect In-
ventory and conscionable Appraisement thereof, and exhibiting the same
into the Register's Office at Philadelphia, on or before the twelfth
Day of October next ensuing; and also a true and just Account,
Calculation, and Reckoning of your Administration, upon your solemn
Oath, to render at or before the twelfth Day of
September in the Year of our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred
and Ninety two or when legally thereunto required. And I do by
these Presents ordain, constitute, and depute you, the said Christian

Grace Administrator of all and singular the Goods and
Chattels, Rights and Credits, which were of the said Deceased, within the
Limits aforesaid, saving harmless, and for ever indemnifying me, and all
other Officers, against all Persons, by Reason of your Administration afore-
said, and saving all other their Rights, &c. IN TESTIMONY whereof
