 and late a Soldier in Capt Robinsons Dragoons Company
 in the State of Pennsylvania in the late Revolutionary
 War with Great Britain do appoint Christian
 Gross my true and Lawfull Attorney for me and in
 my name and for my Use to ask and demand from
 the State of Pennsylvania all the Land which I am
 entitled to by Virtue of any act or acts of the Legisla-
 tur of the Common wealth of Pensy^a for my Services
 Rendered as a Soldier in the war above Mentioned
 Pursuing and Granting unto my said Attorney my
 whole Strength and Authority by these presents in
 and to hold the Premises to have Use and to take all
 Lawfull ways and Means for the Purpose above mentio-
 ned upon the Receipt of any such Lands to pay my
 Requested Receipt or Acknowledgment for the same
 and do appoint one or more attorney or attorneys and
 them for the purpose above mentioned, and do hereby
 Rescind all and revoke Void all other Powers of Attorney
 heretofore given on the above Relation hereby writing
 and holding for Term all and whatsoever my said
 Attorney shall Lawfully do in and about the premises
 by Virtue hereof.
