draw ^{for} and obtain of and from the Hon^{ble} the
Suprem^e executive Council, their agents or
others that may have the charge or direction
of distributing the donation lands, all the
Tract or Tracts of land that is or may be found
due or allowed to me by the State of Pennsylvania
for my services in the P^o Penns^a Regt. of Artillery
as fully amply and effectually as I my self
could or would do being personally present
