LANCASTER Dec: 30th 1799

As Administrator of the Estate of my
 Brother George Grant Deceased, I lay my
 Claim before you with Respect to his depreci-
 ation and Donation Lands &c. my Brother went
 into the Service. in 1776 a Lieutenant afterwards
 was promoted to Capt. in the 9th Pennsylvania
 Regiment in the year 1778 and died in the
 Service on the 10th of October 1779, he has left

 Grant who is now Married to Isaac Dewitt
 your favour in assisting me in getting his
 Just Due, to which he is intitled by his
 Services in the Late war, for his only Child
