As I myself might or could do, where I personally present  
and upon the receipt of the same acquittances or other  
sufficient Discharges for me & in my name to make  
sign seal & deliver as also receive more Attorneys or  
Attorneys under him to substitute & appoint and assign  
at his pleasure to make and further to do perform  
and finish for me & in my name all and singular  
Things or Things which shall or may be necessary
