 Granting unto my said Attorney by these
 presents my full and whole Power Strength and
 Authority in and about the Premises to
 appoint one or more Attorney under Power to
 have use and to take all Lawfull ways and means
 for the purpose above mentioned and upon the Receipt
 of any such Lands to pay any such Taxes to
 the proper Prerequisite or Acknowledgment for the same
 hereby ratifying allowing and holding for firm all
 and whatsoever my said Attorney or Attorneys shall
 Lawfully do in and about the Premises by Virtue hereof
 in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal
 the Twenty ~~Eight~~ day of April One Thousand Eight
 hundred and Four
