This Interpretation made and concluded the
with day of February Anno Domini 1792 between
John W. Hawkins for agent Major in the late
Army of the United States of the one part and
James Murray of the County of Bucks in the
State of Pennsylvania of the other of the other
part Witnesseth that the said John W. Hawkins
for and the consideration of the sum of twenty
pounds Sterling lawfully to him in hand
paid by the said James Murray and for other
valuable considerations doth by these presents
grant bargain sell release and confirm unto
the said James Murray his heirs and assigns
all that tract of land in one of the Donations
Respects in the County of Washington containing
two Acres and fifty Acres and Allowance
So in District No 3 and lot No 58
and that the patent may give me
my heirs and assigns for ever and if
Murray his heirs and assigns beyond it from
as by these presents shall stand beyond it from
me my heirs and assigns for ever and Assignable
and every other person and Person whatsoever
lawfully claiming or to claim by them or under
me. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my
Hand and Seal the day and year above written.
