

Recd. of John Wilson the sum of one pound ten
Shillings hard Money in part pay of a tract of land
containing two hundred acres which land is lawfully
due to me on account of my services during the late
war as appears by my Discharge, and also by an
act of the General Assembly of Pennsylvania made &c
and which land is commonly called Donation Land &c
and which tract of Land I do hereby acknowledge
to have sold from me my heirs &c to the said John
Wilson to him his heirs &c for and in consideration
of seven pounds ten Shillings Pennsylvania Currency
six pounds in wheat at four Shillings per bushel
delivered at East Brown Mill against the first
day of April ensuing the date hereof - the sum
in hard money in hand the Receipt as above I do
hereby acknowledge - and also I am to make over
a sufficient conveyance ^{to the said Wilson} such as Law requires &c
the said Wilson is to pay the office fees (over and
above the above sum) for taking out the patent -
and in witness whereof I have hereunto set my
hand and Seal this 11th Day of July 1769
