 aforesaid my true and Lawfull Attorney for me as Heir and  
 Administrator to the Estate of Samuel Henderfon late a Soldier  
 in the Pennsylvania line in the Army of the United States  
 and Deceased. for me and in my name and for the proper use  
 and benefit of the Heirs of the D. Samuel Henderfon Deceased.  
 To ask, demand and receive all the rights necessary for securing  
 to the Heirs of the D. Samuel Henderfon all the Donation Land  
 due from the State to the D. Samuel Henderfon at his Decease  
 and to have, use and take all lawfull means for the recovery thereof  
 for me and in my name to do all lawfull acts and things what-  
 soever concerning the premises as fully and in every respect as I  
 myself might or could do were I personally present at the doing  
 thereof, ratifying and confirming and by these presents allowing  
 whatsoever my D. Attorney shall in my name lawfully do or cause  
 to be done, in and about the premises, by virtue of these presents.  
 In witness whereof I have herunto set my hand and seal the  
 Twentyfifth day of February in the year of our Lord 1802.
