which from the said United States ^{or Appropriated} is now due and payable to me giving and granting to my said Attorney my sole and full Power and Authority, to take, pursue and follow such legal Courses for the Recovery, Receiving and obtaining of the same, as *I myself* might or could do, were I personally present; and upon the Receipt of the same, Acquittances and other sufficient Discharges for me and in my Name to make, sign, seal and deliver; as also one or more Attorney, or Attornies, under him to substitute or appoint, and again at his Pleasure to revoke, and further to do, perform and finish for me and in my Name all and singular the Thing or Things, which shall or may be necessary touching or concerning the Premises, as fully, thorouly and entirely, as *I* the said

in my own Person ought or could do in and about the same: Ratifying, allowing and confirming whatsoever my said Attorney shall Lawfully do, or cause to be done in and by the Execution of the Premises by Virtue of these Presents.
