Ever. A certain tract of Land in one of the Donation
Districts in the County of Westmoreland containing
two hundred Acres & Allowance of Six per Cent for
Roads &c. in district N^o seven & Lot N^o 200. and I
do desire that the patent may Issue in the Name
and as the property of Richard Leedom His Heirs and
Assigns for Ever. And I do by this presents warrant
& defend it from me my Heirs & Assigns & Every
Other persons Lawfully Claiming from by or Under
me As Witness my Hand and Seal this
twentieth day of November 1786
