

Know all Men by these presents that I Gartham Weicks late a private in the second Pennsylvania Regiment do make constitute & appoint M<sup>r</sup> W<sup>m</sup> Donohat of the County of Northumberland my true and Lawful Attorney, & do authorize him my said Attorney for me and in my Name and to my use to draw a certain Tract of Land of the Donation of the State of Pennsylvania to the Officers & Soldiers of the Pennsylvania Line, & when drawn & ascertained a Deed thereof in my Name & to my Use to accept and receive (paying for me all the legal fees therefor) from the State aforesaid - and to do all such and other Acts touching & concerning the same as I might or could do were I personally present - And I do authorize my said Atty to appoint one or more Attornies under him & the said Appointments to receive at pleasure - Witness my hand & seal this seventeenth Day of February Anno Domini 1787.
