said Richard Ludom the said Tract of Land with the appurtenances
and to the only proper use and behoof of the said Richard Ludom
his heirs and assigns forever - In witness whereof I have hereunto
set my hand and seal this seventh day of April anno Domini

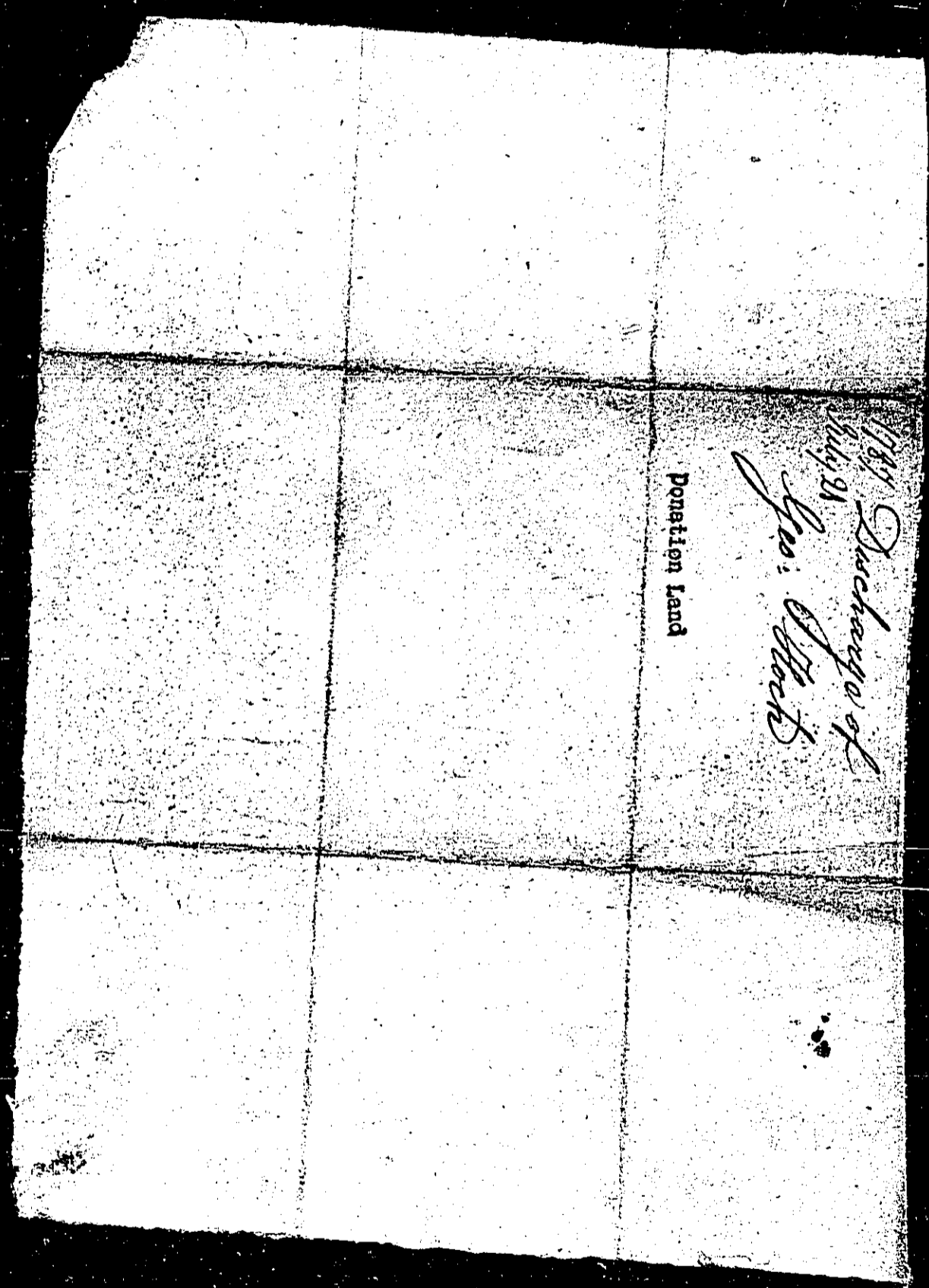
