



Know all Men by these Presents that John

constitute and appoint the honorable John

from the Lottery all the Lands which as a Soldier
I am entitled to from the State of Pennsylvania
and to receive my Patent for the same and
to do and Transact all things in and about
the Premises for me as fully and Absolutely
as if I was personally Present hereby ratifying and
confirming whatsoever my Attorney aforesaid shall
or may do lawfully therein Witness my hand
& Seal this 24th day of August 1787 -
